He shook his head again and said, 'Yesterday I went to bed And from there I saw A big, black cockroach on the floor...'




'And what's more...' the Ranterino said, 'The big black cockroach on the floor Stood up and went and closed the door.




Then it went under my bed. And do you know what it said?' I told the Ranterino I didn't know What the cockroach said. The Ranterino looked at me and said,
