



Gapfills and creative writing worksheets based on high-frequency words

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## TOP 300 Words Writing Activities

AIM: Give students further opportunity to use the Top 300 words within sentence contexts.

Ideally, these worksheets will be used once students have mastered how to read, say and write most of the Top 300 high-frequency words. Completing the Level 2 and Level 3 Worksheets will give them an opportunity to repeatedly scan the reference sheets and consolidate their reading skills for these high-frequency words.
