Narrator 2: All the children in the town hadn't got a single toy!Isn't the Ranterino a naughty boy!!!!

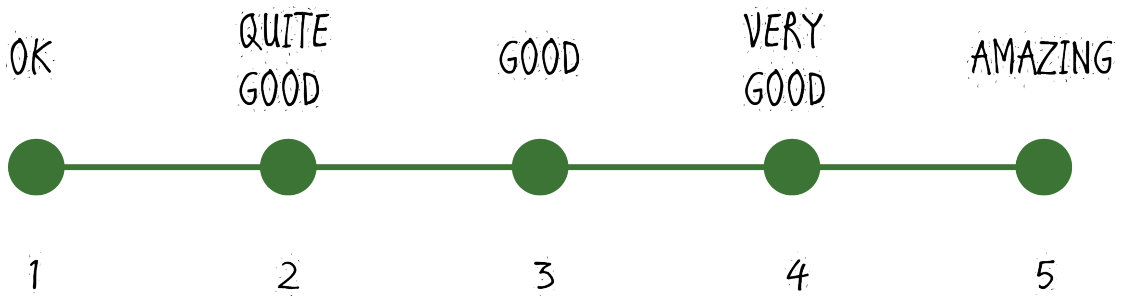
Everyone: The End. Blah, Blah, Blah.

Ranterino: Blah, blah, blah.

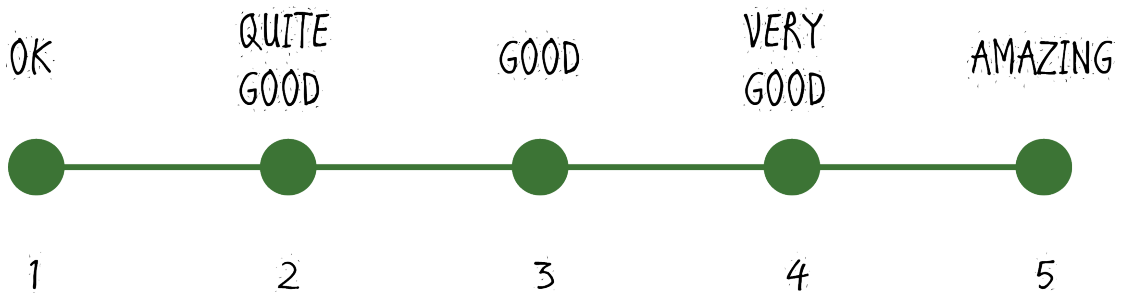
