type	syllables
NOUN	2 - CAR-CLE
meaning A HALF-CAR, HALF-MOTORBIKE	
EXAMPLE 1 THIS CARCLE IS VERY FAST!	
EXAMPLE 2 HOW MUCH DID THAT CARCLE COST?	
EXAMPLE 3 YOU CAN ONLY HAVE 2 PEOPLE ON A CARCLE

type	syllables
VERB	2 - FOR-AGE
meaning TO LOOK FOR FOOD OUTSIDE	
EXAMPLE 1 THE PIGS ARE FORAGING FOR FOOD.	
EXAMPLE 2 DON'T FORAGE IN THE FOREST. THERE ARE BEARS IN THE FOREST!	
EXAMPLE 3 IF YOU ARE VERY, VERY HUNGRY, YOU CAN FORAGE FOR FOOD IN SUPERMARKET RUBBISH BINS.

NOUN	2 - VI-SION
meaning THIS WORD MEANS YOU CAN SEE	
EXAMPLE 1 I HAVE GOOD VISION. I DON'T NEED TO WEAR GLASSES.

SHIPMENT

type	syllables
NOUN	2 - SHIP-MENT
meaning THIS MEANS SOMETHING YOU SEND FROM ONE PLACE TO ANOTHER PLACE.	
EXAMPLE 1 DID YOU GET THE SHIPMENT? WE SENT IT LAST WEEK.	
EXAMPLE 2 THE SHIP IS CARRYING A SHIPMENT OF TOYS.

STATEMENT

type	syllables
NOUN	2 - STATE-MENT
meaning SOMETHING YOU SAY OR WRITE	
EXAMPLE 1 HE MADE A STATEMENT TO THE POLICE.	
EXAMPLE 2 A BANK STATEMENT IS A LETTER. IT TELLS YOU HOW MUCH MONEY YOU HAVE IN THE BANK.	
EXAMPLE 3

TO MANAGE

type	syllables
VERB	2 - MAN-AGE
meaning TO DO SOMETHING DIFFICULT	
EXAMPLE 1 I MANAGED TO DO ALL MY HOMEWORK IN 20 MINUTES.	
EXAMPLE 2 DID YOU MANAGE TO DO ALL YOUR HOMEWORK LAST WEEKEND?

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HIGHLY

HIGHLY

type	syllables
ADVERB	2 - HIGH-LY
meaning THIS WORD MEANS 'VERY'	
EXAMPLE 1 SHE IS HIGHLY INTELLIGENT. VERY, VERY CLEVER!	
EXAMPLE 2 THE BIG FIRE IS HIGHLY DANGEROUS. PLEASE LEAVE NOW!

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VERSION

VERSION

type	syllables
NOUN	2 - VER-SION
meaning THIS WORD MEANS ONE TYPE OF THING	
EXAMPLE 1 2 PEOPLE MIGHT HAVE 2 DIFFERENT 'VERSIONS' OF THE SAME STORY.	
EXAMPLE 2 APPLE MAKES NEW VERSIONS OF IPHONES EVERY 2 YEAR.

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garment

GARMENT

type	syllables
NOUN	2 - GAR-MENT
meaning A PIECE OF CLOTHING, FOR EXAMPLE, A DRESS, OR A SHIRT.	
EXAMPLE 1 SHE DOESN'T BUY CLOTHES IN SHOPS. SHE MAKES GARMENTS AT HOME.	
EXAMPLE 2 A GARMENT IS A PIECE OF CLOTHING, FOR EXAMPLE, A SWEATER OR SOME TROUSERS.	
EXAMPLE 3	

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CARPET

CARPET

type	syllables
NOUN	2 - CAR-PET
meaning SOMETHING YOU PUT ON THE FLOOR. IT'S LIKE A BIG RUG OR MAT.	
EXAMPLE 1 THIS CARPET IS SO SOFT AND WARM. I DON'T NEED TO WEAR SOCKS.	
EXAMPLE 2 DON'T WALK OVER THE CARPET WITH YOUR DIRTY SHOES.
